 Cattle marked with the Brand mark to me belonging  
 One black hogg One Gray horse One Sorrell  
 coloured horse with white hind foot And a Glaz  
 in his face One Bay having One white hind foot  
 One Black horse with a white Tyle One black  
 mare with a white Tyle One black Mare having  
 One white hind foot One Bay mare with a small  
 Starr in her forehead two mare Colts And One horse  
 Colly eall One year Old And One Sorrell mare a  
 Blaze in her face and also a white Tyle all the  
 said horses mares and Colts being branded with the  
 above Brand Mark On the rear of the neck two  
 feather Beds Six pewter plates two dishes  
 two spoons One table two Axes two hoes And  
 three Windlocks And One hundred Bushels of  
 Flour
