my Plantation, Plantation utensils Provisions horses cattle hogs
Sheep &c be sold for one third Cash and a Credit with approved
surety for the balance at twelve months from the day of sale, the
proceeds of which sale after payment of my funeral expenses
and ^{all} lawful demands against my Estate I give and bequeath to
my Brother Benjamin Cockfield's Children now living and to
my Sister Mary McKewan share and share alike that is one
half to the said five Children of Benjamin Cockfield to be kept
at interest and paid them as they arrive at the age of twenty one
years, and the other half of the said sum to the said Mary McKewan.
Secondly I give and bequeath to my Brother Benjamin Cockfield
my Negro fellow named Pompey. Thirdly I give and bequeath
to my Sister Mary McKewan the following Negroes Viz Philis and
her Children Viz Jack, Peter, Darky, Ben, Sharper, and March.
to her during her natural life and after her death to be equally
divided between her three Children Viz Ellen M McKewan, Josiah
A. C. McKewan and William McKewan. Fourthly I give and bequeath
to my Niece Ellen M McKewan three Negroes with their future issue
and increase Viz Silvia and her daughter Bess and the Wench
Marshal. Lastly I hereby appoint and

Independence
