Executors to this my last Will and Testament: and all other Wills and
Testaments, I do hereby revoke. In Witness whereof I have hereunto subscrib-
ed my hand and set my Seal this nineteenth day of November in the
year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
