Mortgage by Joseph Depson to John Brand

I shew attested by these presents that I Joseph Depson
of Charleston in the province of South Carolina Taylor
for and consideration of the sum of Ninety eight pounds Current
money of the province of South Carolina aforesaid have re-
ceived and paid to the said John Brand in full of the sum of Ninety
eight pounds of the said John Brand aforesaid the receipt whereof I
acknowledge by these presents do grant Bargain
& sell unto the said John Brand all that my Negro boy
named Jack do have and to hold the said Negro boy
unto the said John Brand his Exors & Admors
of his own free will & good pleasure and these presents
are upon this Condition words to the effect that if the said
Joseph Depson my Exors & Admors at any time shall well &
lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Brand his
Exors or Admors the said sum of Ninety eight pounds Current
money of the province of South Carolina aforesaid together with Law full
Interest for the same at the rate of five per Cent per Annum
or before the twenty birthday of my said Son using the said
sums presents then these presents to be void & of no
Effect or to be to remain in full force & virtue In
Witness Whereof I the said Joseph Depson have here
unto set my hand & Seal this twenty sixth day of February
