19.8th The State of South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen. I Joseph
Hawcome do make ^{place} publick and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament. In the first ~~I~~ Will and direct that all my just debts be
paid and for this purpose, I hereby empower my Executors & Executors
herein after named to sell my Estate Real and Personal after my
decease and after the payment of my debts I will and direct that
the surplus of the proceeds be divided as follows viz: I give and
bequeath to my Mother Nancy Randal the sum of Two Thousand
Dollars and the remainder I direct my Execution and Executors to
invest in Bank Stocks; the dividends of which I give and bequeath
to my wife Mary Hawcome for and during her natural life and at
her death I give and bequeath the said Stock or Stocks or the
cash may be (so to be purchased as above directed and the dividends
of which I have given to my wife) to my Brother Thomas Hawcome
absolutely and forever. And to prevent the failure of my Will in this
particular, I hereby expressly forbid my Execution and Executors to
have any share or shares of said Stock or Stocks when purchased
as before directed, it being my will that my Executors and not my

Executors shall return the draft in their own possession for nothing, and
allow on the individual receipt, to receive the dividend of the
her life - I further direct and positively enjoin on my Executors to
to furnish each Bank where stock may be purchased with a copy
copy of this my Will as an additional guaranty against the loss
of said stock, the expense of which copies I direct to be paid out of the
dividends herein given to my wife. Lastly I nominate and appoint my
Wife Mary Executrix and my Brother in Law William J. Brewster and
my Brother Thomas Hamscome Executors of this my last Will and
