of sound mind memory and understanding do make public and declare the
following as my last Will and Testament.

In the first place I devise my Executions hereinafter named a soon
as can be conveniently done after my decease to pay all my just and law-
ful debts

Secondly I hereby give devise and bequeath all my Estate real and
personal of every nature and kind whatsoever and wheresoever to my beloved
and wife Caroline J Lockwood, to her, her heirs and assigns forever and I hereby
have my said wife sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.

of October Anno Domini 1836
