And I do authorize and empower my Executor in case the negro girl Celina should

ed, should misbehave, so as to render it expedient for the interest of my children that the should be sold, that my said executor should sell and dispose of the said negro girl Belia, provided that the proceeds arising from her sale be invested in other property for the use and benefit of my said children to be held for the same purposes as above declared in respect to said negro Belia. And I do hereby constitute and appoint Gilbert C. Giddes Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former or other Wills by me made.
