Item, I give and bequeath to my Father Joseph Biglow of Fitzwilliam Cheshire County, New Hampshire, the sum of two hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to my mother Mary Biglow of the same place the sum of two hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to my Sister Catharine Prescott of Royalston, Massachusetts the sum of Two hundred dollars. Item; I give and bequeath to John C. Whittemore of Charleston, infant, the sum of One hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to Georgiana Whittemore of Charleston infant, the sum of two hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to Mary Jane Whittemore of Charleston, infant the sum of One hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to Lyman Bellingham Whittemore of Charleston, infant the sum of One hundred dollars. Item, I give and bequeath to Ann Swinette, Hauschildt of Charleston infant the sum of One hundred dollars.

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of five hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. Item I give and bequeath to my Brother Levi Biglow's Children living at my death the sum of five hundred dollars to be equally divided among them. Item I give and bequeath to Frederick Whitney five hundred dollars. Item, all the rest and residue of my Estate of every kind and nature whatsoever, I give devise and bequeath to my Brother Charles Biglow of Fitzwilliam Cheshire County New Hampshire.

Lastly, I nominate constitute and appoint John Munck and James Bancroft of Charleston, Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
