sound mind and considering the uncertainty of life do make declar-
ation and publish this Instrument of writing to be my last Will and Testa-
ment hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time made. It is my
Will and desire and I do hereby authorize my Executors hereinafter named
or either of them that may qualify on this my Will to enter into and take

Possession of all my real and personal Estate and sell and dispose of the same
at private or public Sale on the Terms they or I am may deem most advantageous
to my Estate and I hereby authorize them or him to make execute and deliver good
and sufficient Titles in Law and in Equity to the purchasers of the same or
any part thereof except such parts and portions of my real and personal property
as I have hereinafter made a special disposition of in this my Will. It is my
Will that the funds or monies arising from the sale of my property together with
any ready money I may be possessed of be appropriated first to the payment
of my funeral Expenses and all just debts the Balance to be appropriated
to the payment of the following legacies should there be a sufficiency of funds
to meet the several legacies if not and there should prove to be a deficiency
a rateable Proportion to be deducted from each of the pecuniary legacies
and in the event of a surplus a rateable Proportion to be added to each
of the pecuniary legacies. To my Daughter Barbara Parquet I give six
hundred dollars also my Slaves Henry and Joe. To my Daughter Mary
Cole I give one hundred dollars. To my Grand-Children Bella Dart
Susan Sesena, Eliza Sesena, and Owen Chatters to each of them I give one
hundred dollars to be paid them as soon as my Executors are in funds.
To Barbara Parquet in Trust for Sarah and Margaret Reid Children
of Margaret Cooper deceased one thousand dollars. To Barbara Parquet
In Trust for Eliza and Alexander, Children of Matilda Sesena deceased
one thousand dollars. To _____ In Trust for Owen Chatters
one thousand dollars. To the Trustee or Trustees of Bella Dart and her
children one thousand dollars the same to be invested in the purchase

of a House and Lot if sufficient if not to be invested in Bank or other good
Securities and the income paid over to Bella Dart until her children
respectively become of age when the principal is to be divided equally

thousand dollars upon the same conditions and limitations as the two
foregoing legacies. To my Slave Nelson I give Twenty five dollars. To Henry
Harry son of Owen deceased I give Twenty five dollars. To Hagar Cole
and her two children William Cole and Mary Cole I give my House and
Lot situated in Pitt Street the portion of this property to which Hagar Cole
will be entitled to be free from the debts and liabilities of her Husband
Thomas Cole. To Adam Humphreys son of Margaret and Joseph
Humphreys I give my Brown Slave Joseph. To Edward Frost as trust
for Hagar Cole I give my Slave Nelson upon the same condition as the fore-
going bequest of a portion of the Pitt Street premises to Hagar Cole. To each
of my Legates and Servants I give a plain suit of mourning the expense of
this bequest not to exceed three hundred dollars. To Barbara Barquet,

glass ware to be equally divided between them. Item I give and bequeath to
my son William K. Knight a feather bed, bolster and pillows. Item
I give and bequeath to my son William K. Knight and my Daughter Cornelia
S. Westendorff all my bed linen, Blankets, Counterpanes and Coverlids to be
equally divided between them. Item I give and bequeath to my son

and bequeath to my grand Daughter Henrietta Sydney Westendorff my
large Silver Soup Spoon. Item I own eight shares in the Bank of South
Carolina. Five of these shares stand on the books of the said Bank in
the names of DeSaussure & Ford in trust for Harriet Smith & her Children
named "Knight" I give and bequeath these five shares to my Children
James D Knight and William K Knight to be equally divided between
them. The three remaining shares in the said Bank stand in the
names of DeSaussure & Ford and H W DeSaussure in trust for
Harriet Smith and her Children. I give and bequeath these three shares
to my Children Harry W Smith, Elizabeth H Hodges and Cornelia S
Westendorff to be equally divided between them; my said two Daughters
shares to be for their sole and separate use. Item all the rest and
