 hundred pounds with Lawfull Interest for the same from
 the date hereof Orer before the twentieth day of March
 which will be in the year of our Lord One thousand seven
 hundred and thirty according to the form and Effect of
 the said recited Obligation and Condition then the
 present Bill of Sale and every Clause Article and Condition
 herein contained shall cease Determine and be utterly void
 and of no Effect any thing herein before contained to the
 contrary thereof in anywise with Stand or In Witness
 Whereof he the said Richard Floyd hath hereunto set his
 hand and seal the thirteenth day of July in the year of our Lord
 One thousand seven hundred and thirty

Memorandum that on this 10th day of Decem^r 1731
 in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and thirty One
 personally came and appeared before me James Ferguson Esq^r one of
 his Majesty's Justices of the peace for Colleton County in the
 Province of South Carolina Margaret Coppel formerly the
 Lawfull Wife of Thomas Peter late of the County and Province
 aforesaid Deceased the being sworn on the Holy Evangelists of
 Almighty God, saith that on the sixteenth day of September
 in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and thirty
 she was delivered by a Child Just and Manner of a Male
 Child to the above named Thomas Peter that the said son was
 by the Name of Mr. Arch^r Sh^r baptised Samuel
 That the said Margaret Coppel left her said son Samuel
 Peter an Apprentice to Henry Vanderdonck on Long Island in

the Government of New York One Thomas Margaret
 (Captains ship) lived at New York the fourth day of
 November in the year 1731 One Margaret seven hundred
 and sixteen. She was by birth a Dutchman's daughter. One Mrs. P.
 Daughter of the female (this) afterwards by the Recorder Mr
 John Thomas Captains (this) afterwards Thomas Peter
 and that her said daughter (this) afterwards Thomas Peter was
 on the 7th day of October 1731 Married to John McQueen and
 that the said Elizabeth Thomas and her said son are both living here
 by this Defendant in the County and Province aforesaid.

Whereas John Godfrey late of this Province, planter
 deceased, lately died intestate, having while he lived
 and at the time of his death, diverse goods rights and
 credits within the province aforesaid, by means whereof
 the full disposition and power of granting the
 administration of all and singular the goods rights
 and credits of the said John Godfrey deceased, and
 also crediting the Accounts (collections and
 reckonings of the said administration and a final
 Dismissal of the same, to me is manifestly known
 to belong. I desiring that the goods, rights and credits
 of the said deceased, may be well and truly administered
 converted and disposed of. Do hereby grant unto the
 said Benjamin Godfrey Jane Mangor Charles Hill &
 Benjamin Whitaker (in whose fidelity in this behalf
 very much confide) full power by the laws of these provinces
 to administer the goods rights and credits of the said Deceased
 which to him in his life time and at the time of his death
 did belong. And to ask Levy recover and receive the same
 and to pay the debts in which the Deceased Deceased obliged
 so far forth as the said goods rights and credits will
 extend according to their rate and value first shown
 in the bills of Exchange of the said Deceased to make a true and
 perfect payment thereof and to receive the same into the
 hands of the said
