2nd Annest J Margaret Glen of Charleston in the State aforesaid being at present very sick and feeble in body but of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding and being strongly persuaded by my sickness and debility of the uncertainty of life do hereby make and Ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say In the first place I desire my Execut

hereinafter named to pay all my just debts as soon as possible after my decease.
Item I give devise and bequeath my Lots in the City of Charleston at the Corner
of Tradd and Legare Streets together with the buildings thereon with my son
John S Glen and Sarah Ann Glen his Wife during their joint lives and
from and after the death of either of them then to the survivors during the
life of such survivor and from and after the death of the survivor then to
all the lawful Children of the said John S Glen and Sarah Ann Glen
as shall be living at the time of the death of the survivor to be equally divided
between or among them forever Item I give and bequeath unto my said son
John S Glen and his Wife Sarah Ann my Slaves Mary Ann and her
Children Kate and Aaron also Sue (Kates Child) Modsey & Isaac ^{Lucy} and daughter
Anelia, to have and to hold the said Slaves with the future issue and
increase of the females unto the said John S Glen and Sarah Ann his Wife
during their joint natural lives or the death of either then to the survivor and
after the death of the survivor then to such child or children of the said John
S Glen and Sarah Ann as should be living at the death of the survivor
absolutely share and share alike Item I give and bequeath unto my
Executors hereinafter named My Trust for the sole use benefit and
behoof of my said daughter in law Sarah Ann Glen not to be liable in
any way for the debts or liabilities of my said son John My Charr and my
Cart horse also my Still and the pot belonging to it my Cart is already
the property of my son John in consequence of the repairs he has put upon it
Item I give and bequeath unto my sons John S Glen and James S Glen
all the crop of my plantation to be equally divided between them Item
I give devise and bequeath unto my son James S Glen all the

all the crop of my plantation to be equally divided between them. Item
I give devise and bequeath unto my son James I Glen my Plantation
in S James Goosecreek with the utensils and Stock except one Heifer I give
Mr Armstrong at her choice Also the following Slaves to wit Betty, Ben
Blackwall Phillis and her three children Tom, Caesar, and the baby
he have and enjoy the same during his life and soon and after the death
of the said James then to such lawful Child or Children of his as shall
be then living to be equally divided between them if more than one forever
Item I give and bequeath to my son James I Glen my other slave Caesar
but if Caesar should prefer being sold then I give the proceeds of his sale to
my said son James absolutely Item It is my Will and desire that an
half acre be reserved on my said plantation for a family burial Ground
Item I give and bequeath my slave George to my Grandson John E Glen forever
Item I give and bequeath my slave Richard to William G Armstrong and
Elera Ann Armstrong his Wife to their ^{mutual} ~~mutual~~ use and behoof forever
Item I give and bequeath my slave Bess (wife of Richard) with her future
issue and increase to Mrs Ann Sader during her natural life and after
her death to the said William G and Elera Ann Armstrong forever. Item It
is my Will and desire that my Carpenter Man, Betty and his Wife Delia
should work out and their Wages be applied toward the payment of my
debts but if that should be considered insufficient then my Will is that
they should be sold and the money applied to that purpose the balance
if any to be held by my Executors In trust for my said daughter in law
Sarah Ann Glen Item I give and bequeath all the rest and residue
of my Estate to my said sons John and James to be equally divided
between them absolutely

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of the said James then to such lawful Child or Children of his as shall
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they should be sold and the money applied to that purpose the balance
if any to be held by my Executors In trust for my said daughter in law
Sarah Ann Glen Item I Give and bequeath all the rest and residue
of my Estate to my said sons John and James to be equally divided
between them absolutely Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my said sons John I Glen and James I Glen and
Wm G Armstrong Executors of this my Will and Testament

I hereby declaring this to be my last Will and Testament and

 excised on same page and one interlineation and one erasure on 1st page

 Negroes, Odo, Betsy, James, Abraham, Doll, Quash, Clarissa
 George, Amey, Joby, Patty, Grace Charles, Chloe, Daniel and Pegg.

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
