to be paid and I authorize and empower my Executors hereinafter named
to sell all my Estate not otherwise disposed of in this Will. I then I give
and bequeath to Thomas Middleton Esquire Five thousand dollars
in trust for my Sister Frances Anna the Wife of John H Wilson Esq.
to her sole and separate use during the life of her Husband And in
case he should survive her Husband then to her absolute use and
disposal but if she should die in the lifetime of her Husband I give
the same after her decease to her Children then living including the issue

of a deceased child of any then living such issue to take in the place of
the parent. Item To my Sisters three Children I give as follows that is to say
to her Son Charles Freer Wilson Three thousand five hundred dollars also my
writing desk without the contents To her daughter Janeudson Wilson one
thousand dollars also the two Drawers the Bedstead, Mattress, two Pillows
Bolster and one of the Looking Glasses in my Chamber And to her Son Thomas
Wilson One thousand dollars The said Money legacies to my Sisters Children are
hereby declared to be payable to them respectively at the age of twenty one years
or day of Marriage The Interest in the mean time to the use of the Legatee.
And if any of them should die under age and unmarried I give the principal
sum hereinbefore bequeathed to him or her to the survivors or survivor of them
the said Charles Freer Wilson, Janeudson Wilson, and Thomas Wilson or to
their issue if either of them shall have left issue living at the happening of
such Contingency. Item To my Cousin Sarah Wilson One thousand
dollars Item to Doctor Joseph Stevens one thousand dollars Item
to Mrs Elizabeth Stevens his Wife One thousand dollars Item to my
friend George H Ingraham two thousand dollars Item to Mrs Nathaniel

of the said slave I give the said sum of four hundred dollars to the Ladies
Benevolent Society Stem I give to George the son of George H Ingraham
one share in the South Carolina Rail Road Company. It is my Will that
my faithful slaves Peter and Patience and her child shall be valued by three
independent persons and allowed to choose their Owners and if they make choice
of any one of my legatees a deduction of Ten per cent shall be made in favor
of such legatee from the appraised value, but if any other person is the purchaser
no deduction is to be made from the appraisement. All the rest residue and
remainder of my Estate whatsoever and wheresoever to be equally divided be-
tween my Sister Frances Ann Wilson my Nephew Charles Jth Don
and my friend George H Ingraham. My Sister and Nephew's share of the residue
to be subject to the same conditions limitations and restrictions as are hereinbefore
declared concerning the pecuniary legacies hereinbefore bequeathed to them
respectively. Lastly I do hereby ordain and appoint my worthy friend
George H Ingraham and Doctor Joseph Stevens Executors of this my last
Will and Testament. hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time
made and declaring this to be my last Will.

Here to Doctor Henry _____ Baylston I give my Negro Slave Frank
who was bequeathed to me by my Aunt Miss Anna Stanyarne and request
him to take the said Legacy as I have received it and I give to the said
Henry Baylston the sum of four hundred dollars during the life of
the said Slave which he will know how to appropriate, and after the death
of the said Slave I give the said sum of four hundred dollars to the Ladies
Benevolent Society. Item I give to George the son of George H Ingraham
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no deduction is to be made from the appraisement. All the rest residue and
remainder of my Estate whatsoever and wheresoever to be equally divided be-
tween my Sister Frances Ann Wilson my Nephew Charles J. Wilson
and my friend George H Ingraham. My Sister and Nephew's share of the residue
to be subject to the same conditions limitations and restrictions as are herebefore
declared concerning the pecuniary legacies herebefore bequeathed to them
respectively. I do by this Innominate ordain and appoint my worthy friends
George H Ingraham and Doctor Joseph Stevens Executors of this my last

But in case my Sister should die before her Husband I give the whole of what I have hereinbefore given to her, to her children

my own right shall be disposed of in the following manner after paying
