N^o. 15 a native of Dantzick on the Baltic, now a Citizen of the United States Resident
of Charleston, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but mindful
of the uncertainty of life, do make, publish and declare this to be my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking and cancelling all former or other
Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made.

I'mprimis, I order and direct all my just and lawful debts to be paid
by my Executors as soon after my decease as convenient.

Item. I give devise and bequeath, all my Estate real and personal of
any kind and nature whatsoever unto my ~~respected~~ respected friend Dr
Vincent Le Seigneur of Charleston, to him, his heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns forever without condition, restriction or limitation whatsoever, and au-
thorize and empower him to sell and dispose of the same in any part
thereof as he deems proper. And I do make it my request to Dr Le Seigneur
at his sole discretion, to apply the interest of the said property in any part
thereof, to the maintenance and supports of a negro woman named
Clara, commonly called known by the name of Clara Hasell during
her natural life, as a bounty to her for her kind attention and care of
me as a nurse during my protracted sickness: And if the said Clara
be sold by her owners, I request Dr Le Seigneur at his sole discretion to

238 = charge the said Clara as her slave and to allow her to bring in wages to him at the rate of one dollar per annum during her life.

Lastly, I nominate, constitute and appoint St Vincent LeSigueur sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament.

I do witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six
