just debts be paid by my said Executors. Whereas, by the last Will

District aforesaid, I am empowered absolutely to dispose of one third
of his whole estate, I do hereby give and bequeath to each and every of
my four eldest children, to wit, Ann, Belle Alexander Nelson Bell,
William Bell and Jane Knox, one hundred Dollars to be paid
first out of my said third.

Item I give and bequeath all my bedding, bed clothes and
wearing apparel to my daughters Ann Bell and Jane Knox to
be equally divided between them.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Bell all the rent
and income between the present date and the time of my decease.

Item I give and bequeath the rent, residue and remainder of
my third above mentioned to my two sons John Dickson & Samuel
Henry Dickson, share and share alike. And I do hereby appoint

be equally divided between them.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Bell all the real and income between the present date and the time of my decease.

Item I give and bequeath the rest, residue and remainder of my third above mentioned to my two sons John Dickson & Samuel Henry Dickson, share and share alike. And I do hereby appoint my three sons, William Bell, John Dickson and Samuel Henry Dickson, Executors of this my Will and Testament making all former and other Wills by me heretofore made. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.
