if any be paid. 2nd I give to my son John One thousand dollars. 3rd I give
to my son Frederick One thousand dollars 4th I give to my son Henry one
thousand dollars 5th I give to my son Charles one thousand dollars 6th
I give to Mary my Mothers picture 7th I give to Sally the large family
Bible, the wafer seal to my Watch and half of my wearing apparel 8th
I give to Ann the Miniature of my son Benjamin half of my wearing apparel
and my Quaker Books 9th I give to Eliza my picture set with pearl 10th
I give to Angelina my watch chain and key 11th I give to Henry my silver
cake basket 12th All the rest and residue of my Estate I leave to be divided
among my daughters in proportion to the amounts each received from their
fathers Estate that is to say the one who received most from the said
Estate is to receive least from my Estate and the one who received least
is to receive most And to the intent that the Will of my husband the
same not having been executed so as to pass real Estate maybe fully exe-
cuted so far as in me lies and in conformity to the family compact
I do hereby declare that I have accepted and do accept the devises and
bequests intended for me by said Will in full satisfaction of every right
claim and demand which I had at his death or would now have but
for said arrangement whether by way of Dower or thirds under the intestates
Act of this State And I do therefore accordingly devise to my Executor
and Executors hereinafter named their heirs and assigns forever all the
Estate right title claim interest or demand whatsoever which I had
at the death of my husband or may be or have by or through him

same not having been executed so as to pass real Estate maybe fully executed so far as in me lies and in conformity to the family compact I do hereby declare that I have accepted and do accept the devises and bequests intended for me by said Will in full satisfaction of every right claim and demand which I had at his death or would now have but for said arrangement whether by way of Dower or thirds under the intestates Act of this State And I do therefore accordingly devise to my Executor and Executors hereinafter named their heirs and assigns forever all the Estate right title claim interest or demand whatsoever which I had at the death of my husband or may be regarded as still having by operation of law in his real estate on Account of his intestacy as to the same in trust nevertheless for the uses and purposes declared by my husband in his said informal Will. And I do hereby ratify and confirm the same and each and every part thereof as to myself and all claiming by claim through or under me as fully and effectually as tho the same had been executed in due form of law 14th I appoint my son Henry Executor and my five daughters Mary, Sally, Ann, Eliza and Angelina Executors of this my Will and revoking all other Wills declare this to be my last Will and Testament.  aforesaid being mindful of the uncertainty of life do make this my last Will
 and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I Will and
 direct that my Executor or Executors hereinafter named immediately after my
 decease shall take in charge all my real and personal Estate now held
 by me and dispose of the same or such portions of it at such time and
 on such terms as they may deem most advantageous for all concerned
 From the proceeds of such Sales It is my Will and desire that they shall
 first pay all funeral expences and mourning for my family and then pay
 such Amounts as may be due by me on the purchases of such property
 I now hold the residue and remainder after the foregoing Amounts are
 paid I Will and direct that my Executor or Executors retain in hands
 and in due time pay all my just and lawful debts It is then my Will
 and desire that the balance then remaining I give and devise unto my
 beloved Wife Juliana Covey for and during her Natural life and I direct
 that the use profit and income be applied by her to the maintenance
 support and Education of herself and our children It is further my Will
 and desire that in case any or all of my real Estate should be sold that
 my said Wife's Dower on the same shall be reserved and paid over to
 her I
