Second - I bequeath to my Daughter Mary Bust One thousand Dollars (\$1000) of my proportion of the Estate of my deceased niece Sarah Webb Legare and my servant named July. Third I bequeath to my daughter Sarah Backsdale Jones my two servants Jupiter and James. Fourth, I bequeath to my daughter Susan Legare Jones my servants Clarissa and Nancy. Fifth, I bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Jones my servant Robin. Sixth, I devise and bequeath to my Grandson Samuel Backsdale Jones, son of Thomas Legare Jones, One thousand acres of land ^{situate} in the Parish of St James Lanter, adjoining lands of Mr William Matthews to be the same more or less, also twelve shares in the United States Bank and one hundred shares in the Planter and Mechanics Bank, when he arrives at the age of twenty one, or day of marriage, to him, his heirs and assigns forever, and in the mean time the income or profits thereof to be applied by my Executors as his Trustees to his support maintenance

and education. But should my said Grand son Samuel Barksdale Jones be under age, unmarried and without leaving children, I then bequeath and assign the aforesaid twelve shares in the United States Bank and the one hundred Thousand acres of land to my Grand children generally share and share alike then him and assigns forever. The one hundred shares in the Planter and Mechanics Bank to go as the residue of my estate is hereinafter disposed of. Seventh. All the rest and residue of my estate which I may be possessed of or entitled unto real or personal, I give devise and bequeath to my three daughters Sarah Barksdale Jones, Susan Legare Jones and Elizabeth Jones share and share alike to them then him and assigns forever, and it is my desire that my furniture should not be appraised, but delivered up to my said three daughters. Lastly I nominate as the Executor of this my will John Berwick Legare, George Buist and Samuel N Stevens.
