I Appoint my Loving Brother John Cook to be my Executor of this my Last Will to pay all my Just Debts and Legacies when they shall become Due & After my Debts & Legacies are paid I give all the Remaining Part of my Estate both Real & Personal to the aforesaid John Cook Reserving all other Wills I make and constitute this my Last Will and Testament. Witness my hand and Seal this fourth Day of March one thousand seven hundred & Thirty One
