Second. I Will and Bequeath to the Independent or Congregational Church at Wappetaw Two hundred Dollars to be paid by my Executors to the Treasurer thereof in trust for the use and benefit of said Church forever.

Third: I Give devise and Bequeath to my Nephew Nathan Legare Toomer and his heirs in trust for the sole and separate use of my beloved daughter Elizabeth T. Morrison during ~~her~~ life time and after her death, for the absolute use of such Child or Children of hers as may survive her and their heirs and assigns forever; All the Residue of my Estate both Real and Personal.

Fourth. It being my intention to sell or convey to my Brother Doctor A. V. Toomer, my faithful Slave Typha, otherwise called Old Typha, in order that she may be rendered comfortable during the remainder of her life, I do hereby withdraw from the legacy above left to my Daughter and Grand Children the sum of fifteen Dollars per annum, during the time the said Slave Old Typha may survive me, which said sum of fifteen Dollars per annum I will and bequeath to my said Brother Doctor A. V. Toomer, to be

Third: I give devise and bequeath to my Nephew Nathan Legare Toomer and his heirs in trust for the sole and separate use of my beloved daughter Elizabeth T. Morrison during ~~her~~ life time and after her death, for the absolute use of such child or children of hers as may survive her and their heirs and assigns forever; All the Residue of my Estate both Real and Personal.

Fourth. It being my intention to sell or convey to my Brother Doctor A. V. Toomer, my faithful Slave Tyrah, otherwise called Old Tyra, in order that she may be rendered comfortable during the remainder of her life, I do hereby withdraw from the legacy above left to my Daughter and Grandchildren the sum of fifteen Dollars per annum, during the time the said Slave Old Tyra may survive me, which said sum of fifteen Dollars per annum I will and bequeath to my said Brother Doctor A. V. Toomer, to be paid yearly to him, by my Executor, hereafter named, trusting that with the said sum he will render her comfortable for the rest of her life. Among the personal property thus devised to my beloved Daughter and Grand^{Children} ~~Daughter~~ there is another Slave, called Old Nancy, whom I have been desirous of manumitting or getting free had the laws permitted it, but as they do not allow it I recommend her particularly to the care and attention of my Daughter trusting that in consideration of my promise to her Father in favor of the said Slave that she will make her life as easy and comfortable as possible as possible. Lastly, I nominate designate and appoint my Nephew Nathan

Lawful Executors. In Testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the second day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred
and Thirty and in fifty fourth year of the Sovereignty and Independence
