in Province of Carolina to see in his and hisfull Authority for us and in Our Name to
take full Rightfull and Lawfull possession of all such Lands and Tenements with the
way of his Aspects as which lands he was belonging and appertaining to our
Mother Jouds at Gibbetown Dorcas also Dying without issue and to ask Demand his said
Property recoveries and debts of and from all and every person and persons whatsoever at any
time of Rent that these will otherwise than shall be due and payable or of Eighty Six Pounds
and 10 Shillings and 6 Pence for the better Obtaining and recovering
the same fees aforesaid Well the Constituents Do hereby Constitute & Appoint our
Daughter Michael Browne to enter into and take possession of all Lands a part
of the Estate and Hereditaments whatsoever pertin. Early this Social Year
Sett. of Land in Charles Town in Bath Carolina aforesaid which said Land did
belong to our Mother Jouds at Gibbetown also that the latter was more effectual
in recovering and Obtaining the premises aforesaid Well do hereby Constitute & Appoint
our said Attorney Michael Browne feale and in Our Behalfe to appear in any Court
or Courts as well in Court of Equity as of Law within these said Province to Complain
that he may sue or Settle hisfull and Effectually to be done in any of his present
service And in all and every His premises aforesaid for us and in our Name to Judge
and Agree with every person or persons concerned as to our said Attorney
service and payment with full power to act and do in all cases His premises
aforesaid And to the best of his full Agents hands of the or parts of Land or other
Tenements and Hereditaments whatsoever for Our use as he shall or may think fit
Consequently with power to Substitute and Appoint our Attorney in accordance with the
Re Obtaining and Recovering all or any His premises and hereditaments aforesaid
to Goods And generally to do for us and our Heirs and Executors and Successors
as if were the said Mary Saltus and Anna Saltus were personally procurator of the
Authority herein given and more fully and simply expressed Well the said Mary Saltus
and Anna Saltus hereby Ratifying alluring and Confirming for ever in Effectual and
