-rection; and my Body to the earth. ^{second} As to the worldly goods wherewith I have been entrusted, I dispose of them as follows. I give and Bequeath to the little girl now living with me named Ellen the sum of ten Dollars as a small testimonial of my regard; the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal and of whatever nature and kind, whether in possession or expectancy, I give and bequeath to my friend Joseph S. Lyons, as a remuneration for the many services he has done me for many years past and as he is now somewhat in debt, and as the estate I may leave at my death is but small I make this bequest to him on the following terms: that is to say: I give & bequeath the said rest and residue of my estate to him during the term of his natural life not subject to the debts, liabilities, contracts or engagements of the said Joseph S. in any way whatever, either the principal or interest hereof; and at his death to any person or persons whatever, that he may appoint; hereby confirming and ratifying any last will ^{and} testament that he may make disposing of the same. Lastly I hereby constitute, nominate and appoint my friends Joseph S. Lyons and Mr Rachel Moses Executor & Executrix of this my last will, hoping that there may be no difficulty attending this my will
