Green, I Mathew Miller Planter of the said Province And Greeting.
Know Yll that I the said Mathew Miller for & in Consideration of the Sum of
Twenty Two Pounds Current Money to me in hand at or before the sealing &
delivery of these Presents well and Truly Paid by Daniel Greene of Charles
Town of the said Province Merchant. The Receipt Whereof I do hereby
acknowledge, my self to be well and Truly Paid and Satisfied have
bargained sold and delivered and by these Presents do bargain
sell and deliver unto the said Daniel Greene Merchant my Indian

Indian named Wang to the said Daniel Greene and to hold the said Indian
Premises unto him the said Daniel Greene his heirs Executors or assigns to the proper
use of him the said Daniel Greene his heirs & assigns in his & their own proper
Goods and Chattels forever Provided always and is hereby Agreed By and
between the said Parties to these Presents that if the said Mathew Miller his heirs
Executors or assigns do and shall Well and Truly Pay or Cause to be Paid unto the
said Greene his heirs Executors or assigns and assigns the said Sum of Twenty Two
Pounds with Lawfull Interest here Money with Lawfull Interest for the same in
or about the first Day of the month of October next ensuing the Date hereof
for the redemption of the said hereby Bargained Premises then this Present
Mortgage & every Clause Article & thing therein contained shall Cease &
Determine & be utterly void any thing to the contrary in any writt Notwithstanding
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 22 day of
July in the year of our Lord in thousand seven hundred & thirty Two
