Bill of Sale by Maurice Rivers unto Robert Daniel
Esq. 1791

NOW all men by these presents that I Maurice
Rivers have sold and by these presents have sold and
delivered unto Landgrave Robert Daniel Esq. as follows
That is to say, One Grey Mare, & did formerly belong to
John Martin, and branded **M** On the mounting shoulder
Likewise one black Mare, which I had of John Miller
in swap for a Horse, being a Mare, David Esq. Esq. Esq.
Laine her Masterfield to Capt. Michael Dorby, And Lastly
a Mare, is formerly did belong to my Wife, which Mare
I swapped with the said Landgrave Daniel some time ago for
a horse and had her again in consideration of a sum of money
which was to pay him the said Landgrave Daniel the first
half the said Mare and which Mare I do acknowledge
I have sold and delivered and will forever defend the same

Against all persons persons whatsoever, the but last

them only the persons names to them and I swapped with
for the full and just sum of Thirty pounds current
money in hand as per the Receipts to appear which I
