my death - Upon her marriage this Annuity to cease and be revoked.
Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Frances Delany for and
during the term of her natural life (after providing for the above mentioned
annuity) the whole income of my estate real and personal of every kind
and nature whatsoever - the estate to be retained and managed by
my Executors and the income paid to her, with liberty to her to use and
occupy my dwelling house and enjoy the services of my negroes. Item
Upon the death of my Wife, I give devise and bequeath all my Estate and
Property real and personal of every kind and nature whatsoever whether
in possession remainder or expectancy unto my friend William Trout
his heirs, executors Administrators and assigns forever. Item I auth-
orize and empower my Executors to sell and dispose of all and every
