That on this present 31<sup>st</sup> Day of July Anno Domini 1729. personally came & appeared before me Jacob Bondy, one of his Majesty's Justices of the peace for Barbadoes, fourty two, Law, Saml Ash & y<sup>e</sup> doctore Wilke being three of the Appraisers appointed by the writ in warrant of Appraisment were sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God to make a full & perfect Inventory & appraisment of all such Goods of Philip Towne late Deceased as should be shewn to them by Benj<sup>n</sup> Law Adm<sup>r</sup> of all & singular the goods Rights & profits of the said Deceased & to cause due return to be made of them I swore before me

It now all men by these presents that Nathl Oade late of Charles Towne in the Province of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina have made constituted & appointed & by these presents do make constitute & appoint & in my stead put & depu<sup>ty</sup> my trusty & well beloved friend Edw. Scull of Charles Towne aforesaid Virtue for me & in my name & by my write to ask Demand sue for Levy Recover & receive all such Sums & Sumes of money Debts, goods, due Acc<sup>t</sup>s Rents Carriours of Rents Lands, Houses, Edifices, Rights, Titles privileges or profits whatsoever which shall be due payable accountable or in any way belong unto me either within the Island of Great Britton or this Province of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina giving & by these presents granting unto the said Edw. Scull who by Vertue hereof

is made & constituted my true & lawfull attorney my full power strength & Authority in & altho the premises to have use take all lawfull wayes & means in my name for the recovery hereof upon receipt of any Sums of money or effects or to make full discharge in my name to make sea & deliver & Generall all & every other Act & Act thing & thinge lawfull & lawfull in the law whatsoever needfull to be done in the premises for the Recovery of all the premises belonging to me as aforesaid, to do Execute & performe as fully & amply as if I my self were personally present, or as if the matter required more speciall Authority than is herein given, Attorneys one or more under him for the purpose aforesaid to make & constitute & against pleasure to revoke Ratifying & allowing for firm & stable and effectual all & whosoever my said attorney shall lawfully do in & altho the premises by Vertue hereof In Witnes whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & seal this Second Day of June in the third Year of the Reign of our Majesty King George the Second Anno Domini 1729
