in the Province of South Carolina planter being now in perfect Health and of full
Disposing thanks be to God, but considering the uncertainty of this Life, I have
therefore these presents to bring last Will and Testament hereby, Revoking and annull
null and void all former Wills and Testaments by me here before made First I Com
soul to God trusting by the merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to have full pa
of all my sins as to my Body I Comitt it to the Earth to be decently buried at the
Discretion of my Executors herein after named In the next place I Order that all
Debts that I Ow and several Charges be paid in Season after my Decease and
my temporal Estate I Give and dispose of the same in manner following First I Give
unto Edwards the eldest Daughter of Edward Edwards formerly first Owner of
being part of a Tract of Land of One hundred Acres commonly called Edwards piece
said Land not to be in the power of the said Edwards nor his Wife or Children
of the said Land but to be in the power of my Executors to Act and Dispose of the
Child till she attain the Age of sixteen or the Day of her Marriage, but in Case
Child should dye before she attain the Age aforesaid then the said Land to fall to the
Widow Mary Edwards but in Case both she should fail or dye then the said Land to fall to the
Widow of Charles Town Item I Give to my Negro Boy Joseph his Freedom
Slavery from me my Heirs Executors or Assigns for ever to him and his Heirs for

Also I Give and Bequeath to the said Joseph Twenty Two Acres of Land to him and his
 heirs for ever he taking his Land at the Department I Give to my Bay Joseph one
 half of my wearing Gown Item I Give to Capt. Richard Smith the Money which he is
 Owe to me which is Fifty pounds, Currenty Also one Gun six foot in the Barrel Item
 Give and Bequeath to Mr. Elizabeth Wagon the wife of Mr. John Wagon Fifty pound.
 Currenty Also to William Wagon a Gun with brasse Pipes upon the Barrel To Mr.
 George Horroth I Give Liberty to Cut of the Land a parcel for his land 25 Trees And a
 to the rest of my Estate and Give to my Executors for the Trouble they shall be at after my
 Death And Lastly I Give Nominate and Appoint my Executors for this my last will and
 Testament, my Friend John Wagon Mariner and George Horroth, November 16. 1729.
