Places which shall be shewn unto you by the said Paul Jungs  
Vnu and Appraise all & Every the said goods being first wornen on  
Holy Evangelist of All mighty God to make a full & Perfect Inventory  
& Appraisement to cause the same to be delivered under your hands  
any three of you into the Secretaries Office in Charles Town  
in order to be Recorded on or before 7<sup>th</sup> Day of May next & then  
I will call to witness and I swear you or any three  
of your whole names are hereunder written to repair to all the  
Ports & Places within this Province, as you shall be directed by  
the said George Dano with the rest & Benefit of all the surgeons the  
goods Rights & Credits of John Martin Deacon wheresoever any  
part of them shall be found or to remaine within the said Ports &  
Places which shall be shewn unto you by the said Paul Jungs  
Vnu and Appraise all & Every the said goods being first wornen on  
Holy Evangelist of All mighty God to make a full & Perfect Inventory  
& Appraisement to cause the same to be delivered under your hands  
any three of you into the Secretaries Office in Charles Town  
in order to be Recorded on or before 7<sup>th</sup> Day of May next & then

of the Governor of South Carolina I have set my Seal  
Know ye that I have made this Seal in consideration of the  
late death of my beloved Daughter Elizabeth late an  
infant child deceased in birth with wonderfull ease and suddenness  
Mother Elizabeth died of paines of birth and consideration of the imminent dangers  
of many more given up to God and by command of my selfe partly for her sake partly for the  
gracious conform unto the said Seal and have set this Seal to witness for to one  
Negro girl about ten years of age named Phillis now in the possession of her said  
Mother Elizabeth the late wife of the said Robert and Roger Lee and brought of my said  
deceased daughter Elizabeth late an infant she went to the said Negro girl  
Phillis together with all her former Inheritance to the said Elizabeth late her husband  
and likewise for her child of the said Phillis late the said negro girl Phillis so given  
Granted & confirmed unto the said Elizabeth late her husband now living with  
and under the care and sustinance of her said Mother Elizabeth Bell & to take  
her and Phillips to her and for her Proper Use and Benefit Against all & Every  
Person or Persons shall & will Warrent and for Ever Defend By these Presents  
In Testimony whereof I the said Noah have here affixed to this my hand and seal  
this ninth Day of April in the Sixteenth year of his Majestys Reign and  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixteyn the  
Year of our Lord and of the Incarnation of our Saviour Christ
