South Carolina Planter of the one part and Joseph
Blake of Berkeley County of the other part witnesseth
That for and in Consideration of the sum of five
Shillings Current money of the said Province
to Peter Belton at the Execution and delivery of
these presents by the said Joseph Blake Whereof
the said Peter Belton doth hereby acknowledge the
receipt and himself to be fully paid and satisfied
and also for and in Consideration of a Bond or
Obligation bearing even date with these presents to
Witness the said Peter Belton doth firmly bind
himself to the said Joseph Blake in the penalty
Sum of Two Thousand Seven hundred Twenty
four pounds Current money of the said Province
and for the payment of One thousand Six
hundred Sixty two Pounds Current money
on the first day of March next ensuing as by the
forewritten Obligation and Condition Doth appear
All for the better securing the said Sum of Six
hundred Sixty Two pounds to be paid as aforesaid
He hath granted bargained sold alienated and confirmed
unto the said Peter Belton Doh his full freely plainly and
absolutely given by him in full payment of all debts and expenses

Unto the said Joseph Blake his natural proffession
Now being by virtue of a Deed bearing date the aymest
before the day of the date of these presents to make thing
from the said Peter Bellon to the said Joseph Blake
in Consideration of Ten shillings Current money
from year commencing from the day next before the
