Bolton of Colleton County by Peter, for of the
One part and Joseph Blake of Berkeley
County Planter of the other part Witnesseth
That for and in Consideration of Ten Shillings
Current money to him the said Peter Bolton in hand
paid at or before the Sealing and delivery hereof
by the said Joseph Blake well and truly paid
The Receipt Whereof the said Peter Bolton
Doth here by acknowledge Hath

Granted bargained and Sold and by these presents
doth Grant bargain and Sell unto the said Joseph
Blake his Exors Admors and Assigns All that
Plantation or Tract of Land containing eight
hundred and Sixty Two Acres of Land formerly belonging
to Isaac Stuart Situate Lying and being in
Colleton County and butting and bounding on
Henry Wilbourns Land and John Dicks and
One Thousand and Fifty of Acres where the
said Peter Bolton hath lately been and butting
bounding on the aforesaid Tract of Land being
on the North side of Green Lake River together
with and Singulas The Houses Out houses Cisterns
Buildings Yards Gardens Pastures Trees Woods
Hedges Fences Gates Wells Ways Waters Watercourses

acres and other the Premises with their appurtenances
unto the said Joseph Blake his Exors Admors and Assigns
from the any great before the day of the date of these
presents for and during the full time and term
of One whole year from thence next ensuing and law-
fully to be completed and ended yielding
and Paying therefor unto the said Peter Bolton or
Exors and Assigns the yearly Rent of One
Pepper Corn on the Last day of the said Term
of the said Shall be lawfully Demanded to the
Intent and purpose that the said Joseph
Blake by Virtue hereof and of the Statute for
Transferring a use into possession may have the
Actual possession of the premises and hereby
be Enabled to accept and take a Grant and release
of The Reversion and Inheritance hereof to him
or his heirs for ever to and for the several uses Intentions
and purposes intended to be mentioned and declared
in a certain Indenture of Release Intended
to be made and bear date the day next after
the day of the date of these presents Between

This Indenture made
The 13th day of June In the year of our
Lord One Thousand seven hundred and thirty
Two and in the fifth year of our Sovereign
George the second of Great Britain France
and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Between
Peter Belton of Colleton County Province of
South Carolina Planter of the one part and Joseph
Blake of Berkeley County of the other part Witnesses
That for and in Consideration of the sum of five
Shillings Current money of the said Province
to Peter Belton at the Executing and delivery of
these presents by the said Joseph Blake Whereof
the said Peter Belton doth hereby acknowledge the
Receipt and says himself to be fully paid and satisfied
and also for and in Consideration of a Bond or
Obligation bearing even date with these presents to
Wherein the said Peter Belton doth firmly bind
himself unto the said Joseph Blake in the special
Sum of Three Thousand Three hundred Twenty
four pounds Current money of the said Province
and to be paid for the payment of One Thousand Six
hundred Sixty two pounds of the current money
on the first day of March next ensuing as by the
said recited Allegation and Condition doth appear
All to the better securing the said Sum of Seven
hundred Sixty Two pounds to be paid as aforesaid
He hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed
and by these presents doth fully finally clearly and
absolutely Grant bargain sell alien Release and confirm
