George The Lion by the Grace of God
of Great Britain, France and Ireland King
Defender of the faith &c. To all, To whom these
presents shall come Greeting. KNOW YE that we
of our Special Grace and favour. HAVE pardoned
Remitted and Released and by these presents we do
Pardon remitt and Release unto Peter French
Late of Charleston in our Province of South Carolina
All that Burglary and felony perpetrated and committed
by him the said Peter French. ~~On~~ the twenty sixth
day of March in the fourth year of our reign and in the
year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and
thirty One at Charleston aforesaid by breaking open
the mansion house of Lawrence Dennis of the same
place Merchant and feloniously taking and
carrying away from thence amongst other things
One blue Linen Sack containing two pair of stockings
of the proper goods and Chattels of him the said
Lawrence Dennis of which said Burglary and felony
the said Peter French stands convicted and is now
under Sentence of death for the same and also all and
all manner of Felony Trespasses Offences Misdemeanors
Contempts concealments and Forfeitures provided the
same do not exceed the Sum of Ten pounds of Lawful
money of Great Britain and all other Innomities
Whatsoever by him the said Peter French before this
time done and perpetrated in our Province of South
Carolina

Carolina, and the suite or suites therein past which to
us do or ought to belong by occasion of all any of the
premises aforesaid and all Judgements Executions &
pains of Death, upon him the said Peter French to be of
right Inflicted, and all penalties & punishments, whatsoever
arising or arising by means of the aforesaid felony and
Burglary or any other Felony by him the said Peter
French before this time done and perpetrated in any
part of our said Province of South Carolina, are
by virtue of these presents pardoned remitted &
released unto him the said Peter French for ever.
On Condition nevertheless that he the said
Peter French do within the space of Three months
from the date of these presents transport himself
out of this Province never to return to the same
again. On penalty of Incurring the same Execution
and pains of death, as if this present pardon had never
been granted. Witnesses our trusty and well beloved
Robert Johnson Esq. Govern. & Commander in Chief
in & over our Province this 27th of March in the
5th year of our reign in the year of our Lord 1732
