I give to my children and grand children, forever, the following
Slaves with the future issue of the Females, to wit. To my son Thomas, Robert, the
son of Susannah: To my grand son Charles Lining (the son of Edward) Jim,
the child of Satya: To my grand daughter Mary Blake Sanders, bated the
child of Satya and I desire my Executors to place the said bated at some Trade,
in the selection of which, they will consult with the Mother of my said grand
Daughter.

I give to my Daughter Mary Blake Lining Sanders, during the term
of her natural life, my Gold Watch & the miniature Pictures of her Father:
and upon her death, I bequeath the watch to her daughter Mary for ever:
and the miniature I give to my son Edward forever.

I desire my Executors whenever the Estate of my deceased Husband is
so far settled & closed, as in their opinion, to warrant this appropriation, to vest
out in their names, in any manner they may deem proper, the sum of One
Thousand Dollars, and the Interest arising therefrom I give to my daughter
Mary Ann Blake Meles, during the term of her natural life and no longer:
and upon her death, I desire that the said sum of one thousand ^{dollars} be dis-
tributed in the same manner as the "Rest and Residue and Remainder
of my Estate" hereinafter provided for.

The Rest residue & Remainder of my Estate of every description (including the share of my deceased Husband shall be fully settled and stored) I give equally & indifferently among my children Edward, Mary B. Sanders, Charles, Thomas & Richard and to their Heirs Executors Administrators & assigns forever; to be divided in such mode as may be deemed most conducive to their own interests. I do empower my said sons to make such division themselves, or to appoint one or more persons to make it; and if it should become necessary to sell the negroes &c for the purpose of a division, I do fully authorize my Executors to dispose of them, either at public or private sale and to execute good and sufficient Bills of Sale for the same & to distribute the proceeds, whether in cash or securities, among my said children.

It is my Will and desire and I do so expressly direct, that that portion of my Estate to which my Daughter Mary B. Sanders, shall be entitled under this my Will, shall be under the control of my Executors, & subject to all the Limitations, Uses, Trusts, and provisions, expressed or intended to be expressed in the Codicil of my deceased Husband bearing date . . . July 1813.

Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my sons Edward Blake Lining Charles Lining, Thomas Lining and Richard Hill Lining Executors of this my last Will and Testament and Trustees for my Daughter Mary B. Sanders & her children.
