 Administrators and Assigns for Ever Provided always and it is hereby agreed between the said Parties
 to these presents That if the said Richard Mills the Father or Natural Son of the said John
 Daniel should be so paid unto the said John Daniel his Executors Administrators or Assigns the said Sum of
 One hundred pounds Current Money with lawful Interest For the Term in the first to sixth day of
 January next ensuing for the Redemption of the said hereby Bargained premises Then this
 present Bill of Sale and every Clause Article and Thing therein contained shall be void and of no Effect
 and be utterly void any thing herein before contained to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of November in
 the third Year of our Majesty Georges and in the Year of our Lord 1734
