In the Name of God Amen! I Rachel Woolf, widow of the City of Charleston, in the State of South Carolina, being in health of body and of sound mind do make this my last Will and Testament. First, I will and devise that all my just debts be paid from the King Street house herein after mentioned. I give devise and bequeath my two story brick house and lot situate in King Street in the City of Charleston and bounded on the South by the Quakers Meeting lot and Church to Bell, wife of Solomon Cohen, Priscilla, widow of David Lopez, Eleanor wife of Philip Cohen, Esther widow of Cherry Moise, to have and to hold the aforesaid house and lot to them and their heirs absolutely, in fee simple and forever, to be equally divided between them, in case they are all alive at my death, but if either of them shall happen, to die before me, then I give the share of her so dying to her child or children and not to be subject to the debts or contract or controul of the present or future husband of any of the above named devisees. Also, I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Cecilia, widow of Hyam Moise my house and lot situate and being on the East side of Orange Street in Charleston, containing in front on Orange Street twenty two feet more or less and in depth seventy five feet more or less, butting and bounding to the South on lands formerly of Saml^r Miller to the east on lands formerly of Henry How, to the North on lands formerly of Gen^l Bull and to the west on Orange Street aforesaid, to have and to hold the said house and lot to her and her heirs in fee simple absolutely and forever. Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Cecilia widow of Hyam Moise, to her and her heirs forever all my apparel plate and linen and all the residue and rest of my estate and all that I have.

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ing lot and Church to Beth, wife of Solomon Cohen, Priscilla, widow of David Lopez, Eleanor wife of Philip Cohen, Esther, widow of Cherry Moise, to have and to hold the aforesaid house and lot to them and their heirs absolutely, in fee simple and forever, to be equally divided between them, in case they are all alive at my death, but if either of them shall happen, to die before me, then I give the share of her so dying to her child or children and not to be subject to the debts or contract or controul of the present or future husband of any of the above named devisees. Also, I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Cecilia, widow of Hyam Moise my house and lot situate and being on the East side of Orange Street in Charleston, containing in front on Orange Street twenty two feet more or less and in depth twenty five feet more or less, butting and bounding to the South on lands formerly of Saml. Miller to the east on lands formerly of Henry How, to the North on lands formerly of Genl. Bull and to the west on Orange Street aforesaid, to have and to hold the said house and lot to her and her heirs in fee simple absolutely and forever. Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Cecilia widow of Hyam Moise, to her and her heirs forever all my apparel plate and kinnen and all the residue and rest of my estate and effects of what nature and kind soever except my common wearing apparel to my sister Meriam, wife of Reuben Levy, the said common wearing apparel to be given to my said sister Meriam after my death. Also I declare that any gift devise or bequest in my said Will to my daughter Bebecca of my house in Orange Street or of any other property whatsoever real or personal is not intended to be one or promissory or part of

Also I declare that any gift devise or bequest in my said Will to my daughter Cecilia of my house in Orange Street or of any other property whatsoever real or personal is not intended by me as payment or part payment of her bond and mortgage of the house in King Street, but that the same Cecilia and all other my creditors are to be paid from the house in King Street and not from any other property real or personal. And I do ordain and declare this present writing to be a codicil to my said Will and that the same shall be annexed thereto and taken as part thereof and do confirm my ~~said~~ Will in every particular thereof that is not hereby altered and revoked.
