 Joyner. 3^{rdly} My Will and desire is, that all the rest exact of my Estate not
 otherwise disposed of, be equally divided between my children and grand chil-
 dren hereafter named, that is to say Isaac Joyner, Joshua Joyner, Mary Jane
 Abbott, Leah Green Joyner Daughter of John Joyner dec^d and Rose Ann
 Caroline Hart daughter of H. Hart dec^d to share and share alike; But if
 Leah Green Joyner, should die without leaving issue, then and in that case
 her share to go to her Brother Samuel Norton Joyner: also my will and desire
 is that, if Rose Ann Caroline ^{Hart} should dye without leaving issue of her body
 and appoint, my sons Isaac Joyner, Joshua Joyner, Timothy Joyner, my son
