of life do make publish and declare this to be my last
Will and Testament hereby cancelling and revoking
all former wills and Testaments by me heretofore made
In witness I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth
Holloway absolutely my servant woman Betty all
my household and kitchen furniture of every kind at my
residence, my horses Chair and Curt and also the sum
of one hundred dollar I also give and bequeath to her
during her natural life my servant man Cato and after
her death I give and bequeath the said Cato to all my
Children living at the time of her death Item I give and
devise to my wife Elizabeth Holloway during the term
of her natural life my house and lot of land wherein I now
reside situated on the South side of Beaufain Street
known by the number 88 also my house and lot of
land situated on the West side of College Street now
occupied by Mr Merchant also my house and lot of
land situated on the West side of College Street now oc-
cupied by Mr Prioleau also my house and lot of land
situated on the South side of Boundary Street next to
the Corner of College Street now occupied by Mr Addis
Item I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth

devise to my wife Elizabeth Holloway during the term
after natural life my house and lot of land wherein I now
reside situated on the south side of Beaumont Street
known by the number 33 also my house and lot of
land situated on the west side of College Street now
occupied by Mr. Perbant also my house and lot of
land situated on the west side of College Street now oc-
cupied by Mr. Priobean also my house & lot of land
situated on the south side of Boundary Street next to
the corner of College Street now occupied by Mr. Addison
I give and devise to the ^{widow and} children of my deceased
son James Holloway my house and lot of land situated
on the west side of College Street wherein they now reside
to be used by them in common as a home and to be equally
divided between them or the survivors of them upon the
youngest child, attaining the age of twenty one years
I give and devise to my son Richard Holloway
my house and lot of land situated at the corner of Boundary
and College Streets also the west tenement of my house
and lot situated on Duncan Street together with the
adjoining lot of land on which the corner shop stands
being at the corner of Duncan & Pitt Streets also the

430 houses and lots on the East Side of Mayzek Street known by the numbers 36 and 38 part of the lands which I recently purchased from Mr William F De Jongh and I will and direct that the Boundary line of the said lots be extended Eastwardly to the lot of the Estate of Mitchell and including the scaffolds of the lot whereon I now reside

Item I give and devise to my son Charles Holloway my house and lot of land situated in Hampstead at the corner of

Street and Truck Item I give and devise to my son Isaac Holloway my houses and lot of land situated on the West side of College Street north of the lot herein before devised to my son James Holloway's widow and children

Item I give and devise to my son Samuel Holloway the East Tenement of my house and lot of land situated in Duncan Street adjoining the lot herein before devised to my son Richard: also my house and lot of land in Boundary Street in the rear of the lot now occupied by Mr Addison with a passage way on Boundary Street of four feet leading to the same, the Eastern line of the said lot to be straight from North to South and bounding on Richard Holloway's lot at the corner of Boundary and College Streets and the west line bounding on land devised to Isaac Holloway as the west line now runs Item I give and devise to my son Edward Holloway my house and lot of land

devise to my son Edward Holloway my house and lot of land
situated on the South side of Beau-fair Street known by the
number 27 and also my house and lot of land situated
on the East side of Mayek Street known by the number
40 being part of the land which I recently bought from
Mr William F De Jongh. Item I give and devise to
my son John Holloway my house and lot of land
on the South side of Boundary Street near Smith Street
now occupied by Mr. Edward Courteney. Item I have
a judgment against William B. Clark entered up on 26
March 1841 in the Court of Common Pleas of Charleston District
for the sum of four thousand six hundred and twenty three
³⁹/₁₀₀ dollars as by reference to the said records will appear.
It is my intention and desire to release the said William
B. Clark from the payment of all the said judgment
except the sum of nine hundred and forty dollars with
interest from 1 October 1842. I do therefore order and direct
my Executors that upon the payment of the said sum of
\$940 with interest from 1 October 1842 in the manner and
from the source hereinafter directed that they do enter
satisfaction of record on the aforesaid judgment against
William B. Clark. Item I order and direct my Executors
to rent out my house and lot of land situated on the West
side of College Street being the first building from Green
Street and apply to me at 15

my son John Holloway my house and lot of land
on the south side of Boundary Street near Smith Street
now occupied by Mr. Edward Courteney. Item I have
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my Executors that upon the payment of the said sum of
\$940 with interest from 1 October 1842 in the manner and
from the source hereinafter directed that they do enter
satisfaction of record on the aforesaid judgment against
William B. Clark. Item I order and direct my Executors
to rent out my house and lot of land situated on the west
side of College Street being the first building from Green
Street and apply so much of the annual rents as in
their discretion they may deem proper to the maintenance
and support of my three grandchildren the children of
my deceased daughter Sarah Clark and the balance

of the said annual rents to the payment of the afore-
said debt of \$940 with interest from the 1st October 1842 due
by William B. Clark, when the balance of the said rents
have paid off the aforeaid debt and interest in full
I give and devise the aforeaid house and lot of land
situated on the west side of College Street to Elizabeth
Holloway Charles Holloway and Samuel Weston
and the survivors of them in Trust for my three Grand
Children the Children of my deceased daughter Sarah
Clark to be equally divided among them or the survivors
or survivor of them at the period when the youngest of
them shall attain the age of twenty one years
After the death of my wife Elizabeth Holloway
I give and devise my house and lot of land wherein
I now reside situated on the south side of Beauvoir
Street known by the number 33 and my house and
lot of land situated on the west side of College Street
now occupied by Mr Berland to my two sons Richard
Holloway and Edwards Holloway. And my House
and lot situated on the west side of College Street
now occupied by Mr Prioleau to my son Richard Hollo-
way and my house and lot of land situated on the
South side of Boundary Street next to the corner of
College Street now occupied by Mr A. J. Smith to my son

College street now occupied by Mr. Richardson my son
Isaac Holloway Item I order and direct my executors
to hold the woman Maria and her children upon the
same terms and conditions as I have heretofore held
them, and allow her the same privilege which I have
heretofore promised her Item I give and bequeath
all my tools bed and jack Screws to all my sons
living at the time of my death who are carpenters by
trade to be equally divided among them Item I order
and direct my Executors to sell and dispose of
all the rest and residue of my Estate real and
personal and to collect the debts due to me, and
with these funds to pay such debts as I may owe
and to divide the surplus of such funds and all
other property I may own equally between my wife
and my children living at the time of my death
Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my
wife Elizabeth Holloway Executor and my sons
Richard Holloway and Edward Holloway Executors
of this my last will and Testament With my hand
and seal this nineteenth day of October in the year
of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & forty two
