in manner and form following First I bequeath
my Seals into the hands of Alm^r by God my Master
hoping that thro' the mercifulnes of Christ
of his Christing on by Sacrament and Edmon
to witness full person and joycons of all my
Sins and sins so far my Body to be buried in
Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Exe
Powers after nominated Item I give and bequeath

unto the poor of the parish of Froome Saltwood
In the County of Somewest In England the sum
of Seven hundred pounds Current money of
South Carolina to be returned for the uses of the
said poor of the aforesaid parish and County —
For ever that is to say the principal to be put
at Interest or to purchase a piece of Land which
the Officer or the said parish with the consent
of the Minister shall think most proper And
the Rents of the said Land or Interest of the said
Seven hundred pounds to be laid out yearly —
In fees to be distributed to the poor families
on the even of Christmas day or the Nativity
of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ forever —
Item I give and bequeath to Anna Parker
wife of a Daughter to Christian Hill and
Elizabeth Kimberley the sum of One hundred
pounds Current money of Carolina which
shall become due to her when the Rent Money
of the said sum above is committed to the poor of
the said parish to the satisfaction of Exector
and not otherwise The Bond to remain at
Interest until the full sum given is raised in
case want and To nominate & appoint my
loving friend Thomas Kimberley to be my sole
Administrator of this my last will and Testament
Renouncing all other Wills and Testaments to me
witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this 22 day April 1732

towards my loving Son and Daughter ~
William and Margaret Little both of the same
parish and County Planter and Spinster with
and Granted and by these presents Do freely ~
Partly and Absolutely give and Grant unto
the said Will: and Margaret Little their Honors
Execution and Singular Two hundred
Acres of Land of y^e plantation which I now live
upon one Negro man named boy the Cow and
Calfo one Mare and Catt now being in my
possession in the Parish beforeward ~
Known by the name of Poppon of which
with their present issue Delivered him and
her the said William and Margaret Little my
Inventory Signed with my own Hand and ~
bearing even date to now and to hold all the
land and hundred acre of Land and Negro man
and Cow and Calfo Mare and Catt in the
said premises or at Dwelling house where so
then the said William and Margaret Little
their Honors Executrix Administratrix from hence
forth as his and hers and their proper Land
of Negro and Calfo mare and Catt absolutely ~
without any manner of Condition in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
and Seal this 26 day of January in the fifth
