**Know all Men** by these Presents that whereas I Richard Harbin of Beaufort County in the Province of South Carolina Planter by my Obligation bearing date soon after the 10th of October last unto Robert Taylor Hugh Butler and Daniel Harwood the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds of the Province aforesaid Conditioned for the payment of One hundred and twenty five pounds two Shillings and Six pence like Current Money in or before the 1st Day of January next ensuing the Date hereof which will be in the Year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine and by the said several Obligations and Condition contained at large appears Therefore for the better satisfying the same of One hundred and twenty five pounds two Shillings and Six pence to be paid unto the said Daniel Harwood the said Obligation and for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds two Shillings and Six pence paid by Robert Taylor Hugh Butler and Daniel Harwood before the sealing and delivery of this present to the said Richard Harbin as acknowledged I have remitted and do deliver and by these presents in plain & open Market do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Robert Taylor Hugh Butler and Daniel Harwood Twelve Cows and Calves from two year Old up to four yearlings Horses, Two left Ear Swallow Tails, Two right Ear speckled and one Four yearling Horses, Two left Ear Swallow Tails, Two right Ear speckled and one Four yearling Horses, and their Juncofs. To have and to hold to the said Robert Taylor Hugh Butler and Daniel Harwood and their Assigns for and provided always and upon this Condition Now to wit that if the said Richard Harbin his Heirs Executors or Assigns shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said Robert Taylor Hugh Butler and Daniel Harwood or either of them their or either of their Heirs Executors or Assigns the said sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds two Shillings and Six pence Current Money of this Province within six months from the Date of the said Obligation according to the true intent and meaning of the before written Obligation and Condition that then these presents shall be void and of none Effect or else shall stand in full force and be in full Force and Effect of this said Richard Harbin have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this first Day of July One thousand seven hundred and Twenty Nine.

**Know all People** to whom these presents shall come I Richard Mills of Charles Towne in the Province of said Province for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds Current Money of this Province to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents and also fully paid by John Daniel of Charles Towne aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I have bargain and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Daniel One Negro Woman slave called Mary with her John and Joseph To have and to hold the said bargain and premises unto the said John Daniel his Executors Administrators and Assigns To the proper use and behoof of the said John Daniel his Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever. Provided always and it is hereby agreed between the said parties to this present that if the said Richard Mills his Executors or Assigns shall and shall well & lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Daniel his Executors or Assigns the said sum of One hundred pounds Current Money with lawful interest for the same on the first day of January next ensuing for the redemption of the said Mary and Joseph for then this present shall be void and every Clause Article and Thing herein contained shall be void and of none Effect and every thing herein before contained to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this first Day of November in the third Year of our Majesty George and in the Year of Our Lord 1729.
