Know all men by these presents That I Richard Davis of Charley
Town in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina a
Merchant for Divisage Cause and Consideration in them
Especially moving **part Given and Granted** and by these
presents Do Give and Grant unto John Moore of Charley Town
aforesaid Gent. All those my two Negroe Girls commonly called
or known by the Names of Sarah and Flora with all their Issues
To have and to hold the said two Negroe Girls called Sarah and Flora
with all their Increase unto and John Moore his heirs Executors
and Assigns forever To the only proper use and benefit
of the said John Moore his heirs Executors and Assigns for
evermore Upon Trust that he the said John Moore shall
and lawfully and faithfully Deliver and send up unto my two Daughters
Anne Dove and Margaret Howe the said two Negroe Girls with
all their Increase in manner and at the time hereinafter limited
and appointed, that is to say the said Negroe Flora with all her
Increase unto my said Daughter Anne when she shall arrive at
the age of sixteen years or Day of Marriage which shall first
happen And the said Negroe Girl Sarah with all her Increase
unto my said Daughter Margaret when she shall arrive to the age
of sixteen years or Day of Marriage which shall first happen
as aforesaid And in case any of my said Two Daughters should happen
to Die or be thereby carried to their rest or to any age of sixteen years
or Day of Marriage as aforesaid That then and in such Case my
Negroe Girl heretofore Given unto and sent so during their lives
Surviving Daughter to her heirs and Assigns forever And Moreover
I Richard Davis the said two Negroe Girls called Sarah and Flora
with their Increase unto and John Moore his heirs Executors and
Assigns forever upon Trust and for the use aforesaid against all
