Deed of Gift in last Anne of Great Britain of Braffour  
to John King & Thomas Gaddon

This Indenture Tripartite made  
the twenty ninth day of January Anno Domini 1730 and  
in the fourth year of the reign of his Majesty King George  
the second in the Province of South  
Carolina between Charles Town in the Province of South  
Carolina Widow and Heir of Richard Spilatt Late of  
Charles Town aforesaid Merchant Decedent of the first  
part Thomas Gaddon of Berkeley County Esq and John  
King of Charles Town aforesaid Merchant of the second  
part and Francis Le Brasfour of Charles Town aforesaid  
Merchant of the third part Whereas there is a  
Marriage by Law solemnized shortly intended to be had  
and solemnized by and between the said Anne Spilatt  
and Francis Le Brasfour Decedent in consideration thereof  
It is agreed that all such personal Estate to which she  
the said Anne is entitled or possessed of by virtue of  
the said Last Will and Testament of her former husband  
the said Richard Spilatt as Legatee shall be to and for  
such uses intents and purposes as are hereafter  
limited and appointed concerning the same and  
that for that purpose the same is to be conveyed to the  
said Thomas Gaddon and John King & Decedent this  
Indenture Witnesseth that in pursuance to  
the said Agreement and for and in consideration of the  
sum of Ten thousand Five hundred Dollars of this Province  
to her the said Anne in hand paid before the sealing &  
delivery of these presents by the said Thomas Gaddon  
and John King the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
and for the conveying the personal Estate of her the said  
Anne to and for the several uses intents and purposes  
herein and under the several and sundry provisions

these presents and in such manner as herein after  
in and by these presents is and there is limited appointed  
appointed and intended that the said Anne Spilatt by  
and with the knowledge priority consent and agrant  
of her the said Francis Le Brasfour testifies by his  
being made a party to and sealing and delivery of these  
presents hath given granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain  
and in plain and open market according to the form  
of Law sell and deliver unto the said Thomas Gaddon  
and John King their Executors Administrators and Assigns  
all and every his <sup>and</sup> third party the personal Estate  
late of the said Richard Spilatt Decedent of which she was  
is or hereafter may be entitled unto or possessed of  
by virtue of the said Will of the said Richard Spilatt  
as a Legatee or heires the same consist of Slaves  
hairs hold goods Stocks Cattle place Jewels plantation  
Tools Outstanding Debts and all other Interests Estate  
right Title claim and Demand of in and to the same  
To have and to hold all and every the forebargained  
promises and its fruits and profits unto the said  
Thomas Gaddon & John King their Executors  
and Assigns for ever Upon Trust Nevertheless and  
to and for the use and purposes herein  
after mentioned limited and appointed and for and concerning  
the same (that is to say) upon Trust that they the said  
Thomas Gaddon and John King and the Survivors  
them and the Executors Administrators and Assigns of either  
do and shall permit and suffer the said Francis  
Le Brasfour and the said Anne his intended Wife  
to have possess and enjoy the said personal Estate  
and the profits thereof for and during the  
Natural life of her the said Anne and from and after
