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Deed of Gift in last Anne of Charles Town of Braffour  
to John King & Thomas Gaddon

This Indenture Tripartite made  
the twenty Ninth day of January Anno Dom. 1730 and  
in the fourth year of the reign of his Majesty King George the Third  
between Anne Platt of Charles Town in the Province of South-  
Carolina Widow and Relict of Richard Spillett late of  
Charles Town aforesaid Merchant Decd of the first  
part Thomas Gaddon of Berkeley County Esq and John  
King of Charles Town aforesaid Merchant of the second  
part and Francis Le Brasfour of Charles Town aforesaid  
Merchant of the third part Whereas there is a  
Marriage by Gods blessing shortly intended to be had  
and solemnized by and between the said Anne Platt  
and Francis Le Brasfour Decd in consideration thereof  
It is agreed that all such personal Estate to which the  
said Anne is entitled or possessed of by virtue of  
the said last Will and Testament of her former husband  
the said Richard Spillett as Legatee shall be to and for  
such uses intents and purposes as are hereafter  
limited and appointed concerning the same and  
that for that purpose the same is to be conveyed to the  
said Thomas Gaddon and John King & Decd this  
Indenture Witnesseth that in pursuance to  
the said Agreement and for and in consideration of the  
sum of Ten thousand Pounds full money of this Province  
to her the said Anne in hand paid before the sealing &  
delivery of these presents by the said Thomas Gaddon  
and John King the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
and for the conveying the personal Estate from the said  
Anne to and for the several uses intents and purposes  
herein and under the several words therein provided

these presents and in such manner as herein after  
in and by these presents is and there is limited appointed  
and directed that the said Anne Spillett by  
and with the knowledge priority consent and agrant  
of her the said Francis Le Brasfour testifies by his  
sole and a party to and sealing and delivery of these  
presents hath given granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain  
and in plain and open market according to the form  
of Law Sell and Deliver unto the said Thomas Gaddon  
and John King their Executors and Assigns  
all and every her the said part of the personal Estate  
late of the said Richard Spillett Decd of which she was  
is or hereafter may be entitled unto or possessed of  
by virtue of the said Will of the said Richard Spillett  
as a Legatee or by her the same consist of all  
have hold goods Horres Cattle place Jewels plantation  
Tools Outstanding Debts and all her Interests Estate  
right Title claim and Demand of in and to the same  
To have and to hold all and every the forebargained  
promises and its increase and profits unto the said  
Thomas Gaddon & John King their Executors  
and Assigns for ever Upon Trust Nevertheless and  
to and for the use and purposes herein  
after mentioned limited and appointed and for and concerning  
the same (that is to say) Upon Trust that they the said  
Thomas Gaddon and John King and the Survivors  
them and the Executors and Assigns of either Survivor  
do and shall permit and suffer the said Francis  
Le Brasfour and the said Anne his intended Wife  
to have possess and enjoy the said personal Estate  
and to receive the profits thereof from and during the  
Natural life of her the said Anne and from and after her

 sole or marriage) by any deed or deed Writing or  
 Writings under her hand and seal, duly executed in  
 the presence of and attested by two or more Creditors  
 Witnessed by her Last Will and Testament or  
 by any Writing purporting to be her Last Will &  
 Testament to be by her signed & executed and attested  
 as aforesaid to Revoke alter Change or remove or  
 make void in the whole or in part all or any of the

 part thereof and by the said Writing or Writings  
 or any other new Writing or Writings to be executed  
 by her and testified as aforesaid (whether she be in  
 her Coverture or whether she be sole or Marriage)

 or Uses Trust or Trusts of the herein before bargained  
 premises or such part thereof as shall be so recorded  
 before justices and after she then dies in next place  
 to shall think proper And the said Francis  
 Le Brasneur for himself has hereunto subscribed  
 with his own hand and seal and agrees to it with  
 the said Thomas Gadsden and John King their  
 Executors and Assigns in manner Expressly

This is today that the said Anne Spall and

 shall and may at any time hereafter during the  
 Coverture with both these said Francis, according to  
 the proviso or power of Revocation aforesaid
