

Book 12 State of South Carolina, I, Robert Wright of Charleston
No. 5 do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament. I give, devise
and bequeath all and singular my estate of every kind whatsoever including
all monies and choses in action unto my beloved wife Catharine Elizabeth Wright
for, and during the term of her natural life, and at her decease I give, devise and
bequeath the same to my three children Mary, Robert and Thomas share and
share alike absolutely and forever. I order and direct however that the share of
my daughter Mary shall be to her sole and separate use, and so as that the same
should remain as a support for her in any case of casualty. In case my wife should
depart this life leaving my son Thomas alive and under twenty one years, I direct
that the Ten shares which I own in the Charleston Bank shall be retained by my Execu-
tors until my said son Thomas shall attain twenty one years, and I direct that
the dividends thereof shall be applied to his maintenance and support - upon his
attaining twenty one, these shares shall be divided among my children in the
same ^{manner} as the rest of my estate. I desire to make provision for my much esteemed
friend Miss Margaret Mc Cain who has been for so many years a much loved inmate
of our family. I know that my wife will take care of her while she lives, but in case
my wife should depart this life and leave Miss Cain surviving, then I give to the said
Margaret Mc Cain my house and lot in George Street, to be used and enjoyed by her
for and during the term of her natural life, and upon her decease the same shall fall
into my estate and be divided among my children as aforesaid. Lastly I nominate
and appoint my beloved wife to be Executrix of this my will, and I hereby revoke
all other wills by me at any time made. In witness whereof I have hereunto my
hand and seal at aiken this ninth day of July One thousand eight hundred and
forty one
