Bill of Sale from Robert Wright to Lionel Chalmers

I, Lionel Chalmers, the present shall certify Robert Wright
of Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina
March 23rd 1732 and in consideration of the sum of two
hundred and twenty pounds good and lawful money of
South Carolina to him in hand at and before the selling
and delivery of these presents well and truly paid by
Lionel Chalmers of Charleston in the Province of South
Carolina the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell and deliver unto the said Lionel Chalmers One
Negro man named Joseph, unto the said Lionel
Chalmers his heirs & assigns and assigns to the
only proper use and behoof of the said Lionel Chalmers
his heirs & assigns and assigns for ever and the
said Robert Wright for my self my heirs and assigns
the said Negro man named Joseph unto the said Lionel
Chalmers his heirs & assigns and assigns of all
persons shall and with warrant and force of law
by these presents to witnes of which I have
put my hand and seal this twenty third day of
March One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two
