Bill of Sale by Maurice Rivers unto Robert Daniel

a horse and had her again in consideration of a sum of money
which was to pay him the said Landgrave Daniel the first
half the said Mare and which Mare I do acknowledge
I have sold and delivered and will forever defend the same
