

Bond from Samuel Crawford to Solomon Tappan

P. Carolina.

Know all Men by these Presents That I Samuel Gandy
Esq. of the County of Berkeley in the Province of South Carolina do hereby
make understandingly bind unto Solomon Toge of the same place my
Heir and Assigns in the full and just Sum of One hundred Liberty and three pence &
Money To be paid unto the said Solomon Toge his Heir and Assigns
as a Reward for the which payment as it was truly to be made if said my Tolls
Shall and lawfully by this present time with my said Heir and Assigns
Day of our Landings. Dated 17th Nov 1730

The Condition of said Obligation is such that if the above bound James Crawford did then and there deliver to any of them, their heirs or assigns, one Day or Days to be played unto this said Solomon Taylor his Estate, Goods or Effects, the full and just sum of Eighty six pounds ten Shillings Current Money or before the Eighth Day of September next Pursuing the Date of this present without Fraud or Guile then this Obligation to be Void and of none Effect or else to be and remain in full force and Virtue.

Now all Men by these Presents That Samuel Crawford of Charles Town
 County in the Province of South Carolina Carpenter in Consideration of Good
 Will and Gracious Minding to me in Hand Paid by Solomon Tignor of the same Place and County
 the sum of Fifty Pounds in ready Money the Receipt And also for and in Consideration of
 Good and Obligation bearing over and above with these presents to deliver unto the said Samuel
 Crawford one Gold and Silver Jewellery unto the said Solomon Tignor in the full value of
 one hundred pounds and these presents Samuel Tignor bindeth himself for the payment of
 Eighty Six pounds and ten Shillings Current Money on the Eighth day of September
 next Ensuing the Date hereof as by this said revised Obligation and Condition well
 and at large appears And for the better Forgoing this said sum of Eighty Six pounds
 and ten Shillings Have bargained and sold and Delivered and by these presents in
 full form of Sale Doe bargain Sell and Deliver unto the said Solomon Tignor his
 Executors Administrators and Assigns One Negro Woman named Hannah with her Child named
 Lucy, three Feather Beds, Two Oval Tables, Two Square Tables, Two Cedar Chests,
 Three Dozens of Chairs, Two pair of Iron Dogs, Two Sauce Pans, Five pounds of Butter
 One Head Mill, One Cart To Have with to Hold the said Bargained Promised
 unto the said Solomon Tignor his Executors Administrators and Assigns for and Against the said
 Samuel Crawford for my self my Executors and Assigns the said Bargained promised
 unto the said Solomon Tignor his Executors Administrators and Assigns Against the said
 Samuel Crawford my Executors and Assigns and all other persons whosoever will come
 and for Ever Debted by these presents Provided nevertheless That if the said
 Samuel Crawford my Executors or Assigns shall not truly pay or Cause to be paid to
 the said Solomon Tignor his Executors Administrators and Assigns the said sum of Eighty Six
 pounds and ten Shillings Current Money on or before the Eighth day of September
 next Ensuing the Date of these presents according to the true intent and meaning of
 the above revised Obligation and Condition for Redemption of the above Bargained
 promised Things this present Bill of Sale to be void Or else to be and remain in full
 Force and Virtue In witness whereof the said Samuel Crawford hath hereunto
 set my Hand and Seal the Eighth day of June in the Year of Our Lord One
 thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Seven.
