I, Samuel, Son of James Island Bouleby County and Province of S. Carolina Planter being weak of Body but of Sound Reason & disposing mind and memory thanks be given and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die and in hopes of a blessed resurrection in and through the only merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ I Commit my Body to the Earth to be buried

in a decent & Christian like manner at the discretion of my Exec^{rs}. I Give Dispose and Bequeath in full and lawful manner following Legitimate Heirs that all my said and Lawful Heirs and personal Experiences be first be first paid by my Executors

Item I Give Dispose my Dear and Well Beloved Wife Sarah Seven twenty five Negroes or Slaves unbranded together with all my other goods and Chattels to her and her heirs for Ever Except what I shall hereafter give to my Daughter Mary Seven

Also I Give to my Loving Wife for the use of my Plantation I now Live on, on James Island During her Widowhood Paying yearly for the same the Rent of five Shillings Current Money also the Use & Benefit of my house in Charles Town During her Natural Life Paying yearly & Every Year the like rent of five Shillings of like Currency to my Executors

Item I Give Dispose and Bequeath to my well beloved William Seven my Plantation and lands I now Live on James Island after the Separation of my said Loving Wife her Widowhood or Death which shall first happen to him and to his Male Heirs Lawfully begotten of his Body only, Continual for and During the Term and Time of one thousand Years From the Date of these Papers Together with a Tract of Land of fifty Acres on said James Island adjoining to Hangers Lands on the same restrictions as aforesaid but if in Case of a Failure of said Male Heirs within the said limited Term aforesaid I will & I do hereby Give Dispose and bequeath the said Lands aforesaid to the next Male Heir so Lawfully begotten to be Continuing the said Term and Time aforesaid hereby debarring any of said heirs or heirs under any Pretence

of right Claim or Demand of and from the same to the said Male Heir make Sale of by any ways means and methods lawfully or lawfully whatsoever also I Give to my said Son William and his heirs for Ever Eight hundred Acres of Land on my said Black River and the residue of my said Lands there I Give Dispose and bequeath to my Son James and Daughter Mary Seven Equally and Indifferently to be shared between them & for them and their Heirs for Ever

Item I Give Dispose and bequeath to my Well beloved Son James Seven the Plantation & Lands he now is settled on to him and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his Body for Ever also the Negroes or Slaves now in his Possession given to Charles to him and his heirs for Ever hereby first allowing my said Loving Wife the Liberty to Exchange out of the one or two at the most but of like Value in like kind

Item I Give Dispose and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Mary Seven my house Lands in Charles Town to her & her heirs for Ever (that is to say after the Decese of my said Loving Wife Sarah Seven also Eight Negro Slaves great and small at the Discretion of my Executors to her and her heirs for Ever together with a Bed and furniture

Item I Give to the Use and Benefit of the Poor Buried Working house in Charles Town the sum of one hundred Pounds Current Money of S. Carolina to be paid by my Executors

Item my will is that all my debts be paid in for the Use of the Plantation by my Executors for building also five hundred Acres on Wareham Neck to be sold by my Executors for the Use of my Plantation

And I do hereby Nominate and Appoint my Dear and Well beloved Wife Sarah Seven my Well beloved Son William Seven and my Beloved Brother in Law John Sandiford my Executors and Executors to this my Last Will and Testament Revoking and Disannulling all former and other Wills and Legacies and Bequests heretofore made by me Samuel Seven & this only to be my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have set to my hand and Seal this third Day of Decembre Anno Dom 1731

always upon the Sale and upon Condition that If the said John Daniel his Executors
shall Die well and Truly or Cause to be Paid unto the said Joseph Dragg the sum of
one hundred and Sixty Pounds or after the first day of March Seventeen hundred
and Thirty Two Without any Deduction of a Payment out of the same then these
Presents and Every Article and Sentence herein Contained shall be void & of no
Effect any thing herein Contained to the Contrary hereof
in any Manner notwithstanding In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this first day of September Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Thirty Two
