and my Diamond and gold Rings for her own separate use so soon
as she arrives at the age of sixteen Years but before her arriving
at said age of sixteen Years my dear sister Mary Martha Brow
to have the possession and use of them as she may desire: my Piano
I also give and bequeath to my said dear child Harriet Sarah
Baker to be given up to her when she arrives at the age of sixteen
Years but in the event of her decease before she shall arrive at
the age of sixteen Years then the said Piano to go to my dear
sister Mary Martha - Item: all my Silver including my Cream
Pots Sugar Dish Spoons and Ladle and all my plate I give
and bequeath to my dear daughter Harriet Sarah Baker to
be put in her possession as soon as she shall arrive at the
age of sixteen Years - Item: My Bureau's Work table and Guitar
I give and bequeath to my dear sister Mary Martha Brow
and all my clothing and wearing Apparel I divide equally
between my said sister Mary Martha Brow and my affec-
tionate Mother Harriet Brow: my work Box I also give and

I give and bequeath the full amount of money coming from
or out of my right of dower in the real Estate of my beloved

Sarah Baker and the interest thereof to be applied for her
education until she arrive at the age of sixteen years at which
period she is to be possessed of the principal to be held for her
under guardianships as an entailed fund the interest ^{only} to be applied
to her sole and separate use the said entailed fund even if
she should marry and notwithstanding her Coverture to remain
entailed the same as if she were a feme sole at her death to
be equally divided among her Children in case she should have
any, but if she should die without Issue the said fund at her
death to revert to my dear Sister Mary Martha Brown, in like man-
ner to be entailed upon her Notwithstanding her Coverture, and
at her death to return to my affectionate Husband Robert L
