No. 18. Boone of Charleston, Widow, being of Sound & disposing mind
& Memory, but mindful of the uncertainty of Life, do make
Publish & declare this to be my last Will & Testament hereby
revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made. Inprimis I
commend my Soul to Almighty God in the humble hope of a blessed
Exemption through the merits of my Redeemer. Item. I order
& direct that my legacies under this Will, and all my debts
& funeral expenses be paid out of the bonds due me by the Estate
of my late Son Thomas Boone deceased. Item. I give & bequeath
to my Grand Daughter Sarah G. Boone the sum of five hundred
Dollars absolutely. Item. I give and bequeath to my Grand Son
John Boone DeSaupure the sum of five hundred Dollars absolutely.
Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Maria Glover
for her sole & separate use for ever, with full power to dispose of the
same by deed or Will my carpenter fellow Charles (the elder) also my
Nephew Dick, also Jack (Diana's son) who was bequeathed to me for
life by Mrs. Mary Boone & after my death to my Children, and also
her share of a Set of the drawers in my chamber, and also my looking
glass upon the express condition however that she release my Estate

from all the right, claim or demand which I may have to or
of the purchase money of the Negroes Jimmy, Rachael & her four children
whom I sold in the year 1814 with the consent of all my children, I
also release all claim to the Negroes Diana & Jack & also execute a
full discharge of all other claims on my estate. Item. I give &
bequeath to my Grand Son John J. Boone absolutely the contents
of drawers in my Chamber. Item. I give & bequeath to the Children
of my late Son Thomas Boone, equally to be divided between them
for ever, my Slave little Charles, also the rest of the furniture in
my bed room, my Books & Spoons, and after the payment by the
said Son, of the pecuniary legacies specified in the preceding
clauses of this Will and all my debts and funeral expenses and
Interest on his Bonds to the time of his Death I release & discharge
the estate of my said Son from the Payment of all his Bonds
to me (except his bond for \$500. which I have given by deed to my
Son John J. Boone) upon the express condition however that the
Executor or Executors of the said Thomas Boone release my estate
from all the right claim or demand whatsoever which his Estate
may have to any part of the purchase money of the Negroes Jimmy
Rachael & her four children whom I sold in the year 1814 with the
consent of all my children, and also release all claim to the Negroes
Diana Jack & Jane, & also execute a full discharge, release & discharge
of all other claims on my estate. Item. I give and bequeath to
my beloved Daughter Susan De Lafore for ever all the rest of

my beloved Daughter Susan DeLaufure for ever all the Rest &
Residue of my Estate of every kind & Nature whatsoever, including
bonds, notes, cash, also including the bench (Sennar) who was bequeathed
to me for life by Mrs Mary Boone & after her death to my children.
Upon the express condition however that she release my estate from
all the right claim and demand whatsoever which she may
have to any part of the purchase money of the Negroes Jimmy, Mabel
& her four children whom I sold in the Year 1814. with the consent
of all my children and also release all claim to the Negroes Jackson
& Katie, & execute a full release & discharge of all other claims
on my Estate. Lastly, I nominate & appoint H. A. DeLaufure
Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
Witness my hand & Seal this Twenty third day of July in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty three
