make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
to wit. To my two daughters Elizabeth Hamlin and Susan Hamlin I give
my house and lot in the village of Greenwich ^{near} Mount Pleasant & I also
also give to my two daughters Elizabeth and Susan the use of my House at
my Plantation on the Sea Shore with fifty Acres of planting land around
the same including the out buildings and the right to cut from the wood land
fencing stuff and wood during the term of their natural lives and no longer
and after their deaths to return to my two sons Thomas Hamlin and John
Hamlin. To my said two daughters Elizabeth and Susan I also give my
two servants Betty and Sam (Sam to Susan and Betty to Elizabeth) together
with all my plate house hold and kitchen furniture. Item I give to my two
sons John Hamlin and Thomas Hamlin (subject to the reservation made in
favor of my two daughters Elizabeth and Susan) my entire plantation on the
Sea Shore to them and their heirs forever. The plantation to be so divided
that the West side on which my son John has settled shall be his and
the East side next to the settlement of my son Thomas shall be his. But
the plantation shall be valued and if one side is considered more
valuable than the other the difference to be made up by giving more land

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to the least valuable side or the one who gets the most valuable side shall
pay the difference to his Brother as they may agree and if after valuing the
land it is found that my sons John Hamlin and Thomas Hamlin will
not receive a full and equal share of my Estate that is to say a one seventh
part each they shall receive as much from the residue of my Estate as will
make their shares equal to their Sectors. All the rest and residue of my
Estate including Cash and Bank Stock I give to be equally divided between
my daughters Elizabeth Hamlin Sarah White Mary Anderson Susan
Hamlin and the Children of Hannah Devoes. That is one fifth part
to Elizabeth Hamlin one fifth part to Sarah White one fifth part to Mary
Anderson one fifth part to Susan Hamlin and one fifth part to the
Children of Hannah Devoes to be equally divided between them and
paid to each as they arrive at the age of twenty one years or days of
marriage. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my two sons John
Hamlin and Thomas Hamlin and James Anderson Executors of this
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former
Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand

thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and in the sixty fourth of
