

Codicil I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife the following
Negroes Anthony, Sabina, Sarah, Rose, Johnny, Abram, ^{Names} Martin,
Nancy and her Children Jimmy, Jacob, Jerry, Bella. ^{See Esq} See Esq
Witness. Sam Wragg, Harris Simcox, O H Dawson. Proved
before Bro Schre Esq O.C.J.D. on the 31st day of October 1839 and
at the same time Qualified Mr Regis See Execution.

State of South Carolina, Charleston District, In
the Name of God Amen. I Sarah Hutchins of the
State and District aforesaid Widow being in good Health of
body and of sound mind desirous now to make publick
and declare this to be my last Will hereby revoking all other
Wills heretofore made by me; And first I commend my soul ^(S)
to God who gave it and my Body to the earth and as to such of
worldly Estate wherewithal I have pleased God to endue me
I dispose of the same as follows. Informes I make that
all my just debts and funeral expences, and all charges
touching the Drawing or otherwise concerning this my Will shall
in the first place out of my Estate be paid, and after payment
thereof then the rest and residue of my Estate of every kind whatsoev
I give to my affectionate Neice Mary B. Nelson and my affectionate
Nephew Morton A. Waring their heirs and assigns forever to be
equally divided between them in the following manner that

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to say all my Negroes shall be valued by their individuality to be married and
appraised by my said Slave May 13 Wilson and my said Negroes
Morton A Waring and after they shall have been so valued, then my
said Negroes Morton A Waring shall secure to be paid to my said
said Negroes Morton A Waring shall secure to be paid to my said
Slave May 13 Wilson one half of the amount of said valuation to
her and her heirs forever. Then the whole of the said Negroes to
remain the property of the said Morton A Waring his heirs and
assigns forever. It is my intention by the foregoing disposition of my
property to give all my Negroes to my Negroes Morton A Waring provided
he secures to be paid to my Slave May 13 Wilson one half of their value
the residue of my Estate to be equally divided between them share and
share alike. I do hereby appoint Morton A Waring my Executor of
this my Will. I signed sealed and dated at Charleston this Third
day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty three
