19th South Carolina, Charleston District, I Simon Morrison of the City of Charleston and District and State aforesaid Cabinet Maker being of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding but well aware of the uncertainty of life do make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills Testaments and Codicils by me heretofore made. I certify that it is my Will and desire that all my Estates real and Personal be sold by my Executors on such terms and conditions as they may direct excepting the two Negro Slaves James and Catherine hereinafter disposed of and from the purchase Money of the Personal Estate to pay all my just debts. Secondly after the payment of all my just debts as before directed I hereby direct and assign my Executors hereinafter named to pay over to my beloved Wife

Maria H. Morison one third part of the Net proceeds of my real Estate which one third part of my real Estate is to be in lieu of all claims to Dower. And I also do give and bequeath to my aforesaid Wife the above named Negro Girl named Catherine. Thirdly It is my Will and desire that the remaining two thirds of the Net proceeds of my real Estate and the remainder of my Personal estate if there be any after the payment of all my just debts be divided into five equal parts and one part thereof be paid to my Sister Mrs Elizabeth Pringle if alive and if she be not alive then to such lawfully begotten Child or Children as may have survived her, one other equal part I will and desire to be paid to my Sister Mrs Agnes Davidson if she be alive and if she be not alive then to be paid to such lawfully begotten Child or Children as may have survived her, one other part I will and desire to be paid to my Sister Mrs Catharine Brown if alive and if she be not alive then to be paid to such lawfully begotten Child or Children as may have survived her, one other equal part I will and desire to be paid to my Sister Euphemia Morison if she be alive and if she be not alive then to be paid to such lawfully begotten Child or Children as may have survived her, one other equal part I will and desire to be paid to my brother Thomas Morison if he be alive and if he be not alive then to such lawfully begotten Child or Children as may have survived him. I further give and bequeath to my brother Thomas Morison my Negro Man Slave James which I direct to be delivered to him and if my brother or either of my Sisters should die during my life time leaving no issue lawfully begotten then and in such case the proportion of my estates bequeathed to such brother or Sister shall devolve upon the surviving issue of the deceased brother or Sister.

or Sister so dying I desire to be equally divided between the survivors
and if any shall have died leaving a Child or Children such Child or
Children shall take their parents part. Lastly I hereby nominate
and appoint my brother Thomas Morrison and my friends Peter Campbell
and James Davidson Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
