the said Benjamin Godin at and before the sealing & delivery
of these presents The receipted Vice of Foxe hereby acknowledges
Have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell and in plain and open Market deliver unto the said
Benjamin Godin three my two Negroe Women Slaves named
Daphney and Jerry I have and to hold the said two
Negroe Women Slaves named Daphney and Jerry unto
the said Benjamin Godin his Executors Admors and Assigns
to him and their proper use benefit and behoof absolutely forever
and if the said Solomon Foxe for my self my Executors and Admors
the said bargain premises unto him the said Benjamin Godin
his Executors Admors and Assigns with Warranty and for ever defended
by these presents Provided always nevertheless and those
persons thereupon Condition That if the said Solomon
Foxe my Executors or Admors shall and do well and truly
Pay or Cause to be paid unto the said above named Benjamin
Godin~~

Given his Executors Admors or Assigns The said Sum
 of money and Interest now due in the Condition of the
 said Bond, on the day and time on which it ought
 to be paid. From this date of date shall Cease accrue and
 be utterly void to all intents and purposes —
 When however And it is Further agreed between
 the party, aforesaid, That untill default be made
 by the said Solomon Tozer in payment of the said
 Sum of money on the day Limited for the payment
 thereof in the Condition of the said Bond That he the
 said Solomon Tozer his Executors and Admors shall
 remain in possession of the said two Negroe Women
 Slaves Without the said Justices Let or Hindrance
 of the said Benjamin Gordin his Executors and Admors
 In Witness Whereof The said Solomon Tozer
 have hereunto set my hand and Seal this ninth

 my Executors Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection
 I shall receive the Same again by the Almighty power of
 God as touching such Worldly Estate Wherewith I have
 pleased God to bless in this Life I have devised and disposed
 of the Same in the following manner and form
 Inprimis I do order in exp^{re}ss point, that my
 funeral Charges with all my other debts which I justly
 owe to any other person or persons be well and truly paid
 and discharged. Item I leave Order and assign
 My Whole Estate Land good and Chattels to be disposed
 and used of Mary Thomson my Wife during her being my
 Widow
